CINEDAYS Festival of European Film is organizing the first ***CINEIndustry Film Market***, which will take place in Skopje, 16-18 November 2018.

Among the activities of the CINEIndustry Film Market, there will be a presentation of jury selected feature films from all Balkan countries to sales agents, distributors, VOD platforms in the form of pitches.

The call is open to production companies and filmmakers from all Balkan countries to submit feature films that are in a final stage of post-production or have been completed in the last year, but haven't been picked up by a sales agent or sold the theatrical and VOD rights to any distributor.

The pitch will take place on the 16th and 17th of November 2018 as part of the CINEDAYS Festival of European Film, which will take place from 8th to 18th November 2018. Each selected participants will have two days to present their projects for potential online and offline distribution. The official language for the presentation will be English.

By taking part in CINEIndustry Film Market you will:

- Gain international visibility for your project
- Meet potential, sales agents, distributors and broadcasters
- Get a chance to win an award

CINEDAYS Festival of European Film will take care of the hospitality (two nights) and transportation for two representatives of each selected project.

2018 CINEDAYS Festival of European Film Competition Rules

General Eligibility

1. Eligible countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Greece, Kosovo, Macedonia, Montenegro, Romania, Serbia, Slovenia and Turkey.
2. No entry fee.
3. Submissions must be done by a completed online entry form. All films must be in English or have English subtitles at the time submitted.
4. Once a film is officially invited and once the producer or his/her duly empowered representative has accepted the invitation, the selected film cannot be withdrawn.
5. Films must be submitted as an online streaming video via a participating submission platform (FilmFreeway) or password-protected streaming URL.
6. In the event of a password change or link change after submitting, you must email the Festival at office@cinedays.com.mk immediately with that change so we may update your record. If the Festival is not notified of the change and the link is found to be inactive or the password to be incorrect, the submission may be deemed ineligible.
7. The films which will be selected, will be advertised in digital form (via social media platforms and profiles), festival programmers and catalogue as well as in outdoor printable. The information from the films that will be communicated to the public will include: year of production, director, cast, information on the crew, official stills from the film, synopsis, trailer, awards received, and festivals attended).
8. Films must be in final post-production stage or have been completed after November 1, 2017.
9. Each selected project will be presented in front of sales agents, distributors, VOD platforms.

Other important notices:

1. Films must be the original work of the right-holders and they must have all the rights for festival screening of the films. The Festival will not support any infringement of the copyright and other rights made by the right-holders whose



work is intellectual share of the film screened. By submitting his/her film, the applicant agrees with the 2018 festival regulations.

2. It is the applicant's duty to obtain all the rights and permissions for the festival screening including rights of third parties such as: music, trademarks, logos and other intellectual property rights.

3. Selection will be announced on October 1, 2018. The jury that is consisted of internationally critically acclaimed film professionals' decision is final.
